Drinking Water Inspectorate Risk Management Approval Scheme (DWIRMAS)

1. Purpose

1.1. The purpose of this letter is to notify companies¹ of the launch of the above Scheme.

2. The Scheme

- 2.1. The Scheme has been jointly developed by the Inspectorate, Lloyd's Register and in consultation with water companies.
- 2.2. The Memorandum of Understanding between the Inspectorate and Lloyd's Register can be found on the Inspectorate's website http://www.dwi.gov.uk/about/working-with-others/MoU_Lloyds_Register.pdf.
- 2.3. Approval under the Scheme, facilitates the variation of sampling frequencies associated with the regulatory sampling programme, which was introduced by regulation 9 of the Water Supply (Water Quality) (Amendment) Regulations 2018.
